### PRIMERA LECTURA— AM 7,12-15

En aquel tiempo, Amasías, sacerdote de Betel, le dijo al profeta Amós: "Vete de aquí, visionario, y huye al país de Judá; gánate allá el pan, profetizando; pero no vuelvas a profetizar en Betel, porque es santuario del rey y templo del reino".

Respondió Amós:

"Yo no soy profeta ni hijo de profeta,  
sino pastor y cultivador de higos.

El Señor me sacó de junto al rebaño y me dijo:

"Ve y profetiza a mi pueblo, Israel" .

### SEGUNDA LECTURA— EF 1,3-14 O 1,3-10

Bendito sea Dios, Padre de nuestro Señor Jesucristo,  
que nos ha bendecido en él  
con toda clase de bienes espirituales y celestiales.

Él nos eligió en Cristo, antes de crear el mundo,  
para que fuéramos santos  
e irreprochables a sus ojos, por el amor,  
y determinó, porque así lo quiso,  
que, por medio de Jesucristo, fuéramos sus hijos,  
para que alabemos y glorifiquemos la gracia  
con que nos ha favorecido por medio de su Hijo amado.

Pues por Cristo, por su sangre,  
hemos recibido la redención,  
el perdón de los pecados.

Él ha prodigado sobre nosotros el tesoro de su gracia,  
con toda sabiduría e inteligencia,  
dándonos a conocer el misterio de su voluntad.

Éste es el plan que había proyectado realizar por Cristo,  
cuando llegara la plenitud de los tiempos:  
hacer que todas las cosas, las del cielo y las de la tierra,  
tuvieran a Cristo por cabeza.

Con Cristo somos herederos también nosotros. Para esto estábamos destinados, por decisión del que lo hace todo según su voluntad: para que fuéramos una alabanza continua de su gloria, nosotros, los que ya antes esperábamos en Cristo.

En él también ustedes, después de escuchar la palabra de la verdad, el Evangelio de su salvación, y después de creer, han sido marcados con el Espíritu Santo prometido. Este Espíritu es la garantía de nuestra herencia, mientras llega la liberación del pueblo adquirido por Dios, para alabanza de su gloria.

### EVANGELIO— MC 6,7-13

En aquel tiempo, llamó Jesús a los Doce, los envió de dos en dos y les dio poder sobre los espíritus inmundos. Les mandó que no llevaran nada para el camino: ni pan, ni mochila, ni dinero en el cinto, sino únicamente un bastón, sandalias y una sola túnica. Y les dijo: "Cuando entren en una casa, quedense en ella hasta que se vayan de ese lugar. Si en alguna parte no los reciben ni los escuchan, al abandonar ese lugar, sacúdanse el polvo de los pies, como una advertencia para ellos".

Los discípulos se fueron a predicar el arrepentimiento. Expulsaban a los demonios, ungían con aceite a los enfermos y los curaban.

### ¿HUMILLARSE PARA SER EXALTADO?

*"Pero el Señor me sacó de detrás del rebaño" (Amós 7:15).*

Amós era un campesino, un pastor y un podador de sicómoros, un don nadie elegido por Dios para profetizar a la nación de Israel (Am 7: 14ss). Jesús también envió a sus apóstoles como "personas sin valía". No les permitió tener posesiones y dinero, con las que muchas personas intentan imponer respeto (ver Mc 6:8-9). Ni siquiera les proporcionó alojamiento (ver Mc 6:10). Los apóstoles tenían el mismo prestigio que las personas sin hogar. Por supuesto, sin credenciales, posición, influencia o poder mundial, era casi seguro que serían rechazados. Así que, Jesús les dijo que estuvieran preparados para sacudir el polvo de sus pies si en algún lugar no los recibían (Mc 6:11).

Jesús es el mismo hoy que ayer (Heb 13:8). Él continúa insistiendo en elegir "lo que es vil y despreciable y lo que no vale nada, para aniquilar a lo que vale. Así, nadie podrá gloriarse delante de Dios" (1 Co 1:28-29). Cuando Jesús nos envía en debilidad, su poder alcanza la perfección (2 Co 12: 9). Jesús prometió que los humildes heredarán la tierra (Mt 5:3-4). ¿Aceptarás volverte humilde? ¿Dejarás que el Señor trabaje por medio de ti?

**Oración:** Padre, que pueda ser humilde en los ojos del mundo y grande en Tus ojos.

**Promesa:** "Bendito sea Dios, el Padre de nuestro Señor Jesucristo, que nos ha bendecido en Cristo con toda clase de bienes espirituales en el cielo" (Ef 1:3).

**Alabanza:** "Yo bajé hasta las raíces de las montañas: sobre mí se cerraron para siempre los cerrojos de la tierra; pero tú me hiciste subir vivo de la Fosa, Señor, Dios mío" (Jon 2:7). ¡Alabado sea Jesús, nuestro protector!

## LOW ENOUGH TO BE EXALTED?

*“The Lord took me from following the flock.” —Amos 7:15*

Amos was a country boy, a shepherd, and a pruner of sycamore trees — a nobody chosen by God to prophesy to the nation of Israel (Am 7:14ff). Jesus likewise sent out His apostles as nobodies. He didn't let them have the possessions and money by which many people try to command respect (see Mk 6:8-9). He didn't even provide them with accommodations (see Mk 6:10). The apostles had about as much prestige as homeless people. Of course, without credentials, status, clout, or worldly power, they were almost certain to be rejected. So Jesus told them to be prepared to shake the dust from their feet if any place did not receive them (Mk 6:11).

Jesus is the same today as yesterday (Heb 13:8). He continues to insist on choosing “the world’s lowborn and despised, those who count for nothing, to reduce to nothing those who were something; so that mankind can do no boasting before God” (1 Cor 1:28-29). When Jesus sends us forth in weakness, His power reaches perfection (2 Cor 12:9). Jesus promised that the lowly will inherit the earth (Mt 5:5). Will you agree to become lowly? Will you let the Lord work through you?

**Prayer:** Father, may I be lowly in the world’s eyes and great in Your eyes.

**Promise:** “Praised be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, Who has bestowed on us in Christ every spiritual blessing in the heavens!” —Eph 1:3

**Praise:** “Down I went to the roots of the mountains; the bars of the nether world were closing behind me forever, but You brought my life up from the pit, O Lord, my God” (Jon 2:7). Praise Jesus, our Protector!
