**PRIMERA LECTURA— JER 23,1-6**

“¡Ay de los pastores que dispersan y dejan perecer a las ovejas de mi rebaño!, dice el Señor.

Por eso habló así el Señor, Dios de Israel, contra los pastores que apacientan a mi pueblo: “Ustedes han rechazado y dispersado a mis ovejas y no las han cuidado. Yo me encargaré de castigar la maldad de las acciones de ustedes. Yo mismo reuniré al resto de mis ovejas de todos los países a donde las había expulsado y las volveré a traer a sus pastos, para que ahí crezcan y se multipliquen. Les pondré pastores que las apacienten. Ya no temerán ni se espantarán y ninguna se perderá.

Miren: Viene un tiempo, dice el Señor, en que haré surgir un renuevo en el tronco de David: será un rey justo y prudente y hará que en la tierra se observen la ley y la justicia. **SEGUNDA LECTURA— EF 2, 13-18**

Hermanos: Ahora, unidos a Cristo Jesús, ustedes, que antes estaban lejos, están cerca, en virtud de la sangre de Cristo.

Porque él es nuestra paz; él hizo de los judíos y de los no judíos un solo pueblo; él destruyó, en su propio cuerpo, la barrera que los separaba: el odio; él abolió la ley, que consistía en mandatos y reglamentos, para crear en sí mismo, de los dos pueblos, un solo hombre nuevo, estableciendo la paz, y para reconciliar a ambos, hechos un solo cuerpo, con Dios, por medio de la cruz, dando muerte en sí mismo al odio.

Vino para anunciar la buena nueva de la paz, tanto a ustedes, los que estaban lejos, como a los que estaban cerca.

Así, unos y otros podemos acercarnos al Padre, por la acción de un mismo Espíritu.

**EVANGELIO— MC 6, 30-34**

En aquel tiempo, los apóstoles volvieron a reunirse con Jesús y le contaron todo lo que habían hecho y enseñado. Entonces él les dijo: “Vengan conmigo a un lugar solitario, para que descansen un poco”, porque eran tantos los que iban y venían, que no les dejaban tiempo ni para comer.

Jesús y sus apóstoles se dirigieron en una barca hacia un lugar apartado y tranquilo. La gente los vio irse y los reconoció; entonces de todos los poblados fueron corriendo por tierra a aquel sitio y se les adelantaron. Cuando Jesús desembarcó, vio una numerosa multitud que lo estaba esperando y se compadeció de ellos, porque andaban como ovejas sin pastor, y se puso a enseñarles muchas cosas.

*"Jesús vio una gran muchedumbre y se compadeció de ella, porque eran como ovejas sin pastor, y estuvo enseñándoles largo rato" (Marcos 6:34).*

La responsabilidad principal de un pastor es alimentar a sus ovejas. Jesús el Buen Pastor se preocupa por alimentar a Sus ovejas. Él mismo estuvo sin comida (Mc 6:31) por alimentar a Sus ovejas enseñándoles largo rato. La manera en que Jesús quiere que mostremos nuestro amor por Él es alimentando a Sus ovejas (Jn 21:17).

Necesitamos alimentación física y espiritual, pero la más importante es la espiritual. Somos alimentados espiritualmente de dos maneras: la Sagrada Comunión y la Palabra de Dios. Jesús dijo: "Mi carne es la verdadera comida" (Jn 6,55) y "El hombre no vive solamente de pan, sino de toda palabra que sale de la boca de Dios" (Mt 4:4).

Este folleto, Un Pan, Un Cuerpo, está destinado a alimentar a las ovejas de estas dos maneras. Enseñamos las lecturas de las Escrituras para la Eucaristía diaria para animar a todos nuestros lectores a leer la Biblia e ir a Misa y comulgar diariamente. Alimentamos a las ovejas de esta manera porque amamos a las ovejas, y especialmente amamos al Pastor.

**Oración:** *Jesús, que, por Tu Espíritu, pierda mi apetito por las cosas de este mundo y te desee a Ti, el Pan de Vida (Jn 6:35).*

**Promesa:** *"En Cristo Jesús, ustedes, los que antes estaban lejos, han sido acercados por la sangre de Cristo" (Ef 2:13).*

**Alabanza:** *"Después oí algo parecido al clamor de una enorme multitud que estaba en el cielo, y exclamaba: '¡Aleluya! La salvación, la gloria y el poder pertenecen a nuestro Dios'" (Ap 19:1). ¡Alabado sea Jesús resucitado!*

## FOOD AND LOVE

***“He pitied them, for they were like sheep without a shepherd; and He began to teach them at great length.” —Mark 6:34***

The main responsibility of a shepherd is to feed his sheep. Jesus the Good Shepherd is preoccupied with feeding His sheep. He Himself went without food (Mk 6:31) to feed His sheep by teaching them at great length. The way Jesus wants us to show our love for Him is by feeding His sheep (Jn 21:17).

We need both physical and spiritual feeding, but the most important is spiritual. We are fed spiritually in two ways: Holy Communion and God's Word. Jesus said: “My flesh is real food” (Jn 6:55) and “Not on bread alone is man to live but on every utterance that comes from the mouth of God” (Mt 4:4).

This booklet, *One Bread, One Body*, is intended to feed the sheep in these two ways. We teach the Scripture readings for the daily Eucharist to encourage all our readers to read the Bible and to go to Mass and Holy Communion daily. We feed the sheep in this way because we love the sheep, and especially we love the Shepherd.

**Prayer:** *Jesus, by Your Spirit, may I lose my appetite for the things of this world and desire You, the Bread of Life (Jn 6:35).*

**Promise:** *“In Christ Jesus you who once were far off have been brought near through the blood of Christ.” — Eph 2:13*

**Praise:** *“After this I heard what sounded like the loud song of a great assembly in heaven. They were singing: ‘Alleluia! Salvation, glory and might belong to our God’ ” (Rv 19:1). Praise the risen Jesus!*
